A684 MIDDLEHAM TO COVER BRIDGE – SURFACE DRESSING

This letter is to inform you that North Yorkshire County Council will be undertaking surface dressing works at the above location.

The works will be carried out in three phases:

- Phase 1 – Road stud removal. Currently programmed to start on Tuesday 05 April and take three working days to complete. The road will be closed during this period.
- Phase 2 – Surface dressing. Currently programmed to start on the afternoon of Thursday 21 April after 13:00 and take one day to complete. The road will be closed during this period. Another letter will be delivered by our surface dressing contractor nearer the time to advise of any further requirements to allow the work to be undertaken.
- Phase 3 – Replace road markings and road studs. Currently programmed to start on Thursday 28 April and take seven working days to complete. The road will be closed during this period. Please ensure vehicles are not parked on the highway within the closure points to allow white lining works to be carried out and prevent delays to the works.

The work is part of an extensive programme and as a consequence it is possible that some adjustment to this start date or the duration of the works may be necessary should unforeseen circumstances such as significant weather events or emergencies on the highway network arise. Signs on site will show the actual dates of the various closures in advance of the works.

The work will generally be carried out between the hours of 07:30 and 17:00. No vehicular access will be available during road closure periods except for emergency vehicles. Pedestrian access will be permitted, our contractors will try to assist you through the use of on-site personnel tasked with managing access.

Please contact the Customer Resolution Centre on 01609 780780 to identify any special access needs you may have during the work period;

If possible, make arrangements to store your vehicle at an alternative location;

Cooperate and comply with any instructions issued by the traffic management operatives and take extra care whilst within the works area;

In order to ensure the works are completed as safely and quickly as possible it would be appreciated if residents could keep journeys to a minimum.
