White lines – Low Thorpe

Need refreshing. Also rest of the white lines in the village could do with a refresh as very faded. **Clerk to contact Highways Area 1.**

Also worth mentioning that Fell Lane potholes have been patched so why not the main road near the church? **Clerk to request Highways Area 1 to look at the drop off at the edge of the road near the church and to do some remedial works.**

Grass outside the bus shelter
